

AG – Agriculture

“The purpose of this district is to provide for continued farming activities, conserve agricultural land and reaffirm agricultural uses, activities and operations within the agricultural zoned areas. It is the further purpose of this district to maintain, and promote, the rural character of this land as well as promote the continuance and viability of the farming and agricultural uses.” [§ 267-53. AG Agricultural District. [Amended by Bill 11-04, as amended]]



In addition to farming, AG zoned land may support business.
